



Let's go Flying...

With an all up weight of about 16.5 lbs, and thrust of over 20 lbs, needless to say, this Cub and do almost anything!

Take off acceleration can be as rapid as you like, cruise is at about 33% throttle, most aerobatics at only 50 to 66% throttle, and once in a while, rarely, 100% is used.

Unlimited knife edge at 50% power, rolling circles at 66% power and so on. WOW!!!

This combination can be flown a total of almost 20 minutes on a charge, however, heat can really build up if hot-dogging, so we have found that 8 to 10 minute flights is more practical. First flights should be SHORT to check temperatures and build from there. A \$40 pocket infrared temp gauge is well worth every penny. Yes, you can fly twice on one charge allowing for a cooling off period in between. (Remove batteries to cool after EVERY flight).
